**Annual Report – 2019 - 2020**

**About the College:**

St Joseph's College, Hassan, established in the year 2009, aims at a holistic and integral formation of the students, fostering in them a spirit of academic excellence, character formation and social concern, shaping and moulding them to become “men and women” for others. The college not only imparts quality education but also creates exceptional individuals with empathy and sense of social justice. The college empowers the students to lead a self-reflected life, think critically about beliefs and opinions and exercise judgement and discernment based on ethics and morals.

The college is affiliated to Mysore University, one of the premier Universities in Karnataka. The motto of the college “Service is the light of life” serves as an inspiration to the students to become a beacon of light and hope in the country and in the world at large. The educational system at St Joseph's College, Hassan, includes a pattern of training that will imbibe the basic values of tolerance, humanity, consistency and pursuit towards excellence in every student. Since its inception, the institution has shown growth and progress in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

The courses offered at St Joseph's College, Hassan equips students with Commerce and Business administration education that instills in them an ability to understand and interact with the business world and provides them with skills required to excel in the field of Business and Commerce. Under Commerce SJC offers Bachelor of Commerce and under Management SJC offers Bachelor of Business Administration. The choice based credit system introduced in the year 2017 is another such initiative that offers students a choice of courses in interest to their career goals. The college also offers certificate courses such as Spoken English, Tally ERP 9.0, SAP, CA/CS coaching and career guidance classes.

**Management of the college:**

St. Joseph's Institutions in Hassan are managed by the 'Society of Jesus', a Catholic Order founded by St. Ignatius of Loyola. They are generally identified as Jesuits. The (Jesuit) aims and objectives of the college, other than imparting the academic requirements of teaching and study are specially catered towards a holistic training of the personality in order to make them persons for others, for the society at large and for the country. College, Hassan is managed by the Hassan Jesuit Educational Society (HJES) which also has a few other institutions of education at the school and college level under its care. The HJES aims at executing the noble objectives of the Jesuit philosophy of education.

The Governing Body of the College creates an academic vision for the college and oversees all the programmes. It is the highest decision making authority of the institution. It comprises of members of Hassan Jesuit Educational Society (HJES), nominees from the University, nominee from the mentor institute, Director and faculty members of the college. The governing body of the institution can approve new programs. It meets twice a year and reviews admission and examination reports, takes important decisions on academic aspects, examination and evaluation, and sanctions the academic calendar. It also deals with exceptional cases.

#### **Cells and committees:**

##### **1) IQAC:**

The Internal Quality and Assessment Cell of SJC, Hassan which is headed by Mr Pradeep Kumar and Mr Joseph Mathew for the year 2019-2020 works towards streamlining the efforts of the institution in promoting academic excellence and innovative practices driven by self-reflection, collaboration and feedback. Quality Management Team initiates quality enhancement measures and oversees the day-to-day functioning of all aspects of the college. IQAC team of the institution works towards the realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. ##### **2) Examination Committee:**

Examination processes which are time-tested with their proven effects are employed to mark the levels of knowledge acquisition. Grades are but a humble measure of the efforts in this endeavour. The Examination Department has been consistently striving to reform the examination system. With the implementation of the Continuous Internal

Assessment (CIA) it has been proven to be one of the best ways of evaluating the learning outcomes of the students. Students can individually approach the faculty for specific learning requirements. Besides, the CIA provides a flexible space to the faculty for helping students improve their grades impacting the End Semester Examination scores effectively. Mr Guru Prasad and Ms Jenisia Lasrado, the coordinators of the exam Committee are responsible for the preparation and evaluation of the certifying examination. It guarantees the quality of the internal examination and the marks allotted to the students. Certain tasks and powers are allotted to the exam committee by the administration. It is responsible for setting and moderation of the question papers as per the guidelines of the university. Internal examinations and end semester examinations are conducted on periodic intervals.

### 3) Placement Cell:

The Placement Cell of the college consistently works towards meeting the standards of the internal and external stakeholders of the institution. Pre Placement Process and Skill Development comprise of activities like career mapping, career guidance and workshops, internships for the final/pre-final year students to prepare them for placements in their outgoing year.
